To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas *Thomas C. Harris of the County of Washtenaw, Michigan* has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Detroit, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *Thomas C. Harris*, according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 25th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the first half of the fourth quarter of Section, Town of *Paris*, in Township four north of Range *fourteen* East in the District of *Land* subject to sale at Detroit, Michigan, containing eighty acres according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Thomas C. Harris*,

NOW KNOW YE, that the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the promises made in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made, and provided here given and granted, and by their parents do give and grant unto the said *Thomas C. Harris* and to his heirs the said tract above described to have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatever nature therewith belonging unto the said *Thomas C. Harris*,
